INJUNCTION

Complaint filed February 21, 2008

1 The Order to Show Cause re Preliminary Injunction came on for hearing before this Court
2 on April 22, 2008. Plaintiff, The Regents of the University of California ("The Regents"), and
3 Defendants Hillary Roney, Tim Rusmiser, Kevin Olliff, and Linda Faith Greene appeared by and
4 through their respective counsel. The Court, having considered the pleadings and evidence
5 submitted by the parties, and having heard argument of counsel, finds that good cause appears for
6 the issuance of an injunction pending the final determination of this action.

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT DEFENDANTS UCLA PRIMATE**
8 **FREEDOM, ANIMAL LIBERATION BRIGADE, ANIMAL LIBERATION FRONT,**
9 **LINDA FAITH GREENE (AKA LINDY GREENE), HILLARY RONEY, KEVIN OLLIFF,**
10 **RAMIN SABER AND TIM RUSMISER, AND ANY INDIVIDUAL OR ORGANIZATION**
11 **OPERATING ON THEIR BEHALF OR IN CONCERT WITH DEFENDANTS, ARE**
12 **HEREBY RESTRAINED AND ENJOINED FROM:**

13 a) Committing any act of violence or making any threat of violence against any
14 person known or believed to be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or
15 oversees animal research, or a family or household member who resides with such individual;

16 (b) Vandalizing, damaging, or threatening to vandalize or damage real or personal
17 property belonging to any person known or believed to be an employee or student of The Regents
18 who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research, or a family or household member who
19 resides with such individual;

20 (c) Harassing any person known or believed to be an employee or student of The
21 Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research, or a family or household member
22 who resides with such individual, as defined in California Code of Civil Procedure § 527.6;

23 (d) Picketing, demonstrating, or protesting within 50 feet of any residence (to be
24 measured from such dwelling) known or believed to be that of an employee or student or a family
25 or household member of any employee of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees
26 animal research;

27 (e) Picketing, demonstrating, or protesting within 150 feet of any residence (to be
28 measured from such dwelling) known or believed to be that of an employee or student or a family

1 or household member of any employee of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees
2 animal research between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m.;

3 (f) Trespassing, entering, coming onto, or interfering with the use and enjoyment of
4 any real property (including residential property) owned, occupied, or in the possession of any
5 person known or believed to be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or
6 oversees animal research;

7 (g) Violating any city or municipal regulation regarding noise;

8 (h) Placing or maintaining upon any website or otherwise disseminating any private or
9 personal information, including home addresses, home phone numbers, mobile phone numbers,
10 email addresses or vehicle license plate numbers, regarding any individual known or believed to
11 be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research, or
12 a family or household member who resides with such employee or student.

13 Additionally, Defendants shall post the following language: "Notice: The Superior Court
14 of California has issued an order prohibiting certain activity relating to The Regents of the
15 University of California and their employees, pursuant to Los Angeles Superior Court Case
16 No. SC097145 (Santa Monica)" in 10-point font on the website of Defendant UCLA Primate
17 Freedom and the primary websites for Defendants Animal Liberation Front
18 (www.animalliberationfront.com) and Animal Liberation Brigade in a manner such that the
19 posting would ordinarily be displayed to a user viewing the page.

20 The above Preliminary Injunction is effective immediately on the date set forth below.
