 RESTRAINING ORDER AGAINST ALL
 DEFENDANTS

1 **TO DEFENDANTS UCLA PRIMATE FREEDOM, ANIMAL LIBERATION**
2 **BRIGADE, ANIMAL LIBERATION FRONT, LINDA FAITH GREENE (AKA LINDY**
3 **GREENE), HILLARY RONEY, KEVIN OLLIFF, RAMIN SABER AND TIM RUSMISEL**

4 Based on Plaintiff's Application for Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show
5 Cause Re Preliminary Injunction; Memorandum of Points and Authorities in support thereof; and
6 supporting Declarations submitted by Norman Abrams, John Adams, Peter Anton, Lynn
7 Fairbanks, Joaquin Fuster, Derrick Huckaby, Brian Malonc, Dario Ringach, Arthur Rosenbaum,
8 and Wendy Sugg, the Court finds that good cause exists to grant Plaintiff's Application. The
9 Court further finds that:

10 (A) Irreparable Injury: As required by Code of Civil Procedure Section 527(c)(1), the
11 supporting Declarations submitted by Plaintiff set forth specific facts showing that great or
12 irreparable harm will result to Plaintiff The Regents of the University of California's ("The
13 Regents") employees and students unless this Application is granted. This harm includes trespass
14 on the property of employees of The Regents, disruption of The Regent's business operations,
15 harassment, intimidation and threats of violence to The Regent's employees and their families.
16 These injuries are great because they are significant in and of themselves, and also because they
17 could easily lead to violent confrontation. The harm is irreparable because it would not be
18 possible to accurately ascertain an amount of damages, if any, that would adequately compensate
19 The Regents or their employees for these injuries.

20 (B) Notice to Defendants: As required by Code of Civil Procedure Section 527(c)(2),
21 the supporting declarations submitted by Plaintiff certify in writing that Plaintiff gave or attempted
22 to give notice of this hearing to the Defendants. To the extent that notice did not reach a
23 Defendant, this order shall be granted without notice pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section
24 527(c)(2)(B), because Plaintiff has made diligent and reasonable efforts to effect notice, but were
25 unable to reach that Defendant.

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU AND EACH OF YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE AT 8:30 a. m. on March 12, 2008, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard in Department F of the above-entitled Court, located at 1725 Main Street, Santa Monica, California, why Defendants UCLA Primate Freedom, Animal Liberation Brigade, Animal Liberation Front, Linda Faith Greene (aka Lindy Greene), Hillary Roney, Kevin Olliff, Ramin Saber and Tim Rusmiser, ~~and any individual or organizations operating on their behalf or in collaboration with Defendants UCLA Primate Freedom, Animal Liberation Brigade, Animal Liberation Front, Linda Faith Greene (aka Lindy Greene), Hillary Roney, Kevin Olliff, Ramin Saber and Tim Rusmiser~~ should not be restrained and enjoined pending trial of this action from committing or furthering the commission of any and all of the following acts:

- (a) Committing any act of violence or making any threat of violence against any person known or believed to be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research, or a family or household member who resides with such individual;
- (b) Vandalizing, damaging, or threatening to vandalize or damage real or personal property belonging to any person known or believed to be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research, or a family or household member who resides with such individual;
- (c) Harassing any person known or believed to be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research, or a family or household member who resides with such individual, as defined in California Code of Civil Procedure 527.6;
- (d) Picketing, demonstrating, or protesting within 50 feet of any home known or believed to be that of an employee or student or a family or household member of any employee of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research;
- (e) Picketing, demonstrating, or protesting within 150 feet of any home known or believed to be that of an employee or student or a family or household member of any employee of

1 The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research between the hours of 6:00 p.m.
2 and 9:00 a.m.;

3 (f) Trespassing, entering, coming onto, or interfering with the use and enjoyment of
4 any real property (including residential property) owned, occupied, or in the possession of any
5 person known or believed to be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or
6 oversees animal research;

7 (g) Violating any city or municipal regulation regarding noise;

8 (h) Placing or maintaining upon any website or otherwise disseminating any private or
9 personal information, including home addresses, home phone numbers, mobile phone numbers,
10 email addresses or vehicle license plate numbers, regarding any individual known or believed to
11 be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research, or
12 a family or household member who resides with such employee or student.

13 1. Defendants and their agents, employees, representatives, and all persons acting in
14 concert and participation with them or with actual notice of this order shall:

15 (a) Post the following language: "Notice: The Superior Court of California has
16 issued an order prohibiting certain activity relating to The Regents of the University of California
17 and their employees, pursuant to Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. SC097145 (Santa
18 Monica)" in 10 point font on the website of Defendant UCLA Primate Freedom and the primary
19 websites for Defendants Animal Liberation Front (www.animalliberationfront.com) and Animal
20 Liberation Brigade in a manner such that the posting would ordinarily be displayed to a user
21 viewing the page.

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, DEFENDANTS UCLA PRIMATE FREEDOM, ANIMAL LIBERATION BRIGADE, ANIMAL LIBERATION FRONT, LINDA FAITH GREENE (AKA LINDY GREENE), HILLARY RONEY, KEVIN OLLIFF, RAMIN SABER AND TIM RUSMISEL ARE HEREBY TEMPORARILY RESTRAINED from committing or furthering the commission of any and all of the following acts:

(a) Committing any act of violence or making any threat of violence against any person known or believed to be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research, or a family or household member who resides with such individual;

(b) Vandalizing, damaging, or threatening to vandalize or damage real or personal property belonging to any person known or believed to be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research, or a family or household member who resides with such individual;

(c) Harassing any person known or believed to be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research, or a family or household member who resides with such individual, as defined in California Code of Civil Procedure 527.6;

(d) Picketing, demonstrating, or protesting within 50 feet of any home known or believed to be that of an employee or student or a family or household member of any employee of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research;

(e) Picketing, demonstrating, or protesting within 150 feet of any home known or believed to be that of an employee or student or a family or household member of any employee of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m.;

(f) Trespassing, entering, coming onto, or interfering with the use and enjoyment of any real property (including residential property) owned, occupied, or in the possession of any person known or believed to be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research;

(g) Violating any city or municipal regulation regarding noise;

1 (h) Placing or maintaining upon any website or otherwise disseminating any private or
2 personal information, including home addresses, home phone numbers, mobile phone numbers,
3 email addresses or vehicle license plate numbers, regarding any individual known or believed to
4 be an employee or student of The Regents who conducts, supports, or oversees animal research, or
5 a family or household member who resides with such employee or student.

6 Additionally, Defendants shall post the following language: "Notice: The Superior Court
7 of California has issued an order prohibiting certain activity relating to The Regents of the
8 University of California and their employees, pursuant to Los Angeles Superior Court Case No.
9 SC097145 (Santa Monica)" in 10 point font on the website of Defendant UCLA Primate Freedom
10 and the primary websites for Defendants Animal Liberation Front
11 (www.animalliberationfront.com) and Animal Liberation Brigade in a manner such that the
12 posting would ordinarily be displayed to a user viewing the page.

13 The above Temporary Restraining Order is effective immediately on the date and time set
14 forth below. This Temporary Restraining Order shall be and remain in effect until such time as
15 the Court has ruled on Plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction.

16 This Order to Show Cause and supporting papers shall be sent to Defendants, and each of
17 them, by United States Express Mail (or by a method reasonably calculated to reach the recipient
18 by the next business day) no later than Monday, February 25, 2008. Proof of such service shall be
19 filed and delivered in the manner provided by Code of Civil Procedure Section 527. Such service
20 shall be valid if made to the last known address for each Defendant (or their attorneys).


21 The following briefing schedule shall apply: Any opposition papers to the Order to Show

23 papers to such opposition shall be filed and served on Defendants no later than March 10, 2008.
